## About The College

Govt. Degree College Kupwara was established in 1988. Affiliated to University of Kashmir and recognized by the UGC under section 2(f) and 12 (B), the college started from a makeshift campus near Boys Higher Secondary Kupwara and in the year 2000 it shifted to its new/permanent campus at Bohipora on Kupwara Villgam road about 2 kms from the town centre. Spread over 8 hectares of land the college has an Administrative Block two 8-room Lecture Blocks, a Science Block, a Library Block, Computer Applications Block, an Admission Block, an Auditorium, a Meeting Hall, and a few more small buildings to run undergraduate courses in Arts, Science, Computer Applications and Commerce streams. Two separate hostels one each for Boys and Girls with an intake capacity of 60 are available to provide residential facilities for students' coming from far-off places. Initially created with an intake capacity of around 350 students, the current enrolment of the college has exceeded 4000 with 45% girl students. The enrolment of girls has increased over the years which are indeed a healthy sign for this educationally backward area. It has been the endeavor of the college ever since its inception to strive hard to live up to the expectations and the aspirations of its different stakeholders. The college has the unique distinction of being the first among young colleges to get NAAC accreditation with B+ grade in 2004 and recently got grade "A" by NAAC in 2022. It is due to the dynamic, able and unstinted guidance of the faculty that the number of admissions of our students for different courses in the reputed universities of the country has substantially increased over the years and our students are now making to various competitive exams at regional and National level. The college firmly believes that only curricular activities are not enough to ensure all round development of the students, hence different co-curricular activities are regularly conducted in the college throughout the year to inculcate moral values, community sense and leadership qualities among its students and to boost and carve out their hidden talent.

## About Kupwara

District Kupwara is the northern frontier district with an area of 2379 square kilometers, having more than 240Kms of LOC and came into existence in the year 1979. The district kupwara is exquisitely beautiful with vibrant culture, diverse heritage, unique folklore and vast meadows. kupwara district is located between Pir Panchal land Shams Bari mountain ranges. These mountain ranges have beautiful meadows and pastures in their bosom which provide grazing ground for cattle and sheep. Kupwara also has health resorts and tourist spots for the adventurous souls. Tourist destination in Kupwara include Bangus Valley, Sadhna Top, Satbaran Lolab and Nagriwari.

## College Library

Library occupies a prominent position and it is an important and integral part of the teaching learning programme. The collection of GDC Kupwara library is 28000 books including 9000 reference books. The college library is fully computerized with SOUL 2.0 software and OPAC is available for students and faculty for searching books. The library provides photocopy, internet and printout facility to users. The Library block has three reading rooms and browsing centre with 18 nodes.

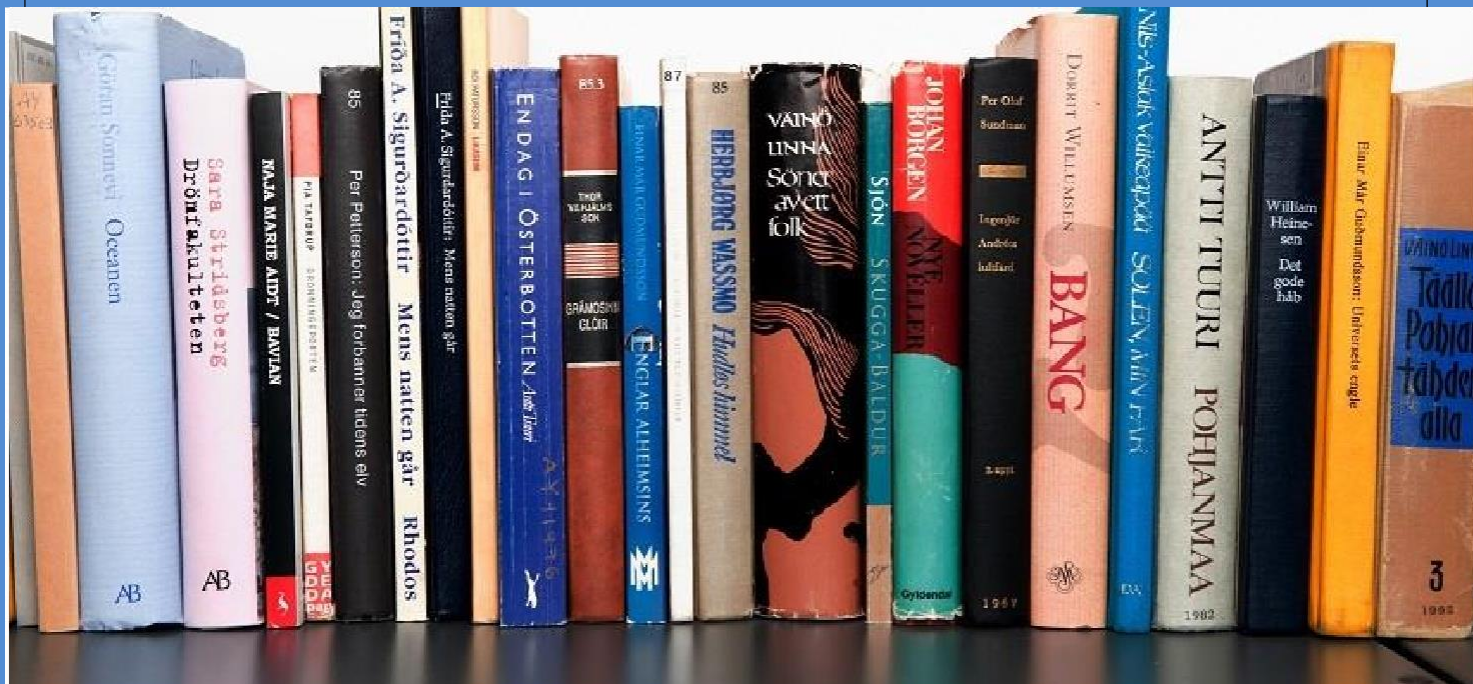
