WORKSHOPS AND SEMINARS 2022-2023

1. On July 4, 2022, a one-day workshop on "Computers as a Career Option" was conducted in collaboration with "Hi-Fi Computers", College Road Kupwara in which a considerable number of students participated.

2. INTERNATIONAL DAY OF YOGA

On the eve of the International Day of Yoga, the NSS units and Physical Education Department of the College, in collaboration with the Department of AYUSH organised week-long workshop on the theme "Yoga for Humanity under the banner of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav. The workshop was inaugurated on June 16, 2022, by Incharge Principal, Prof. G. R. Ganai, in presence of programme officers NSS Dr. Mehraj Bashir and Dr. Shazia lone and District coordinator AYUSH Dr. Altaf Ahmad Sheikh and Physical Training Instructor Mr. Ashfaq Ahmad. 61 students, NSS volunteers, and students of an adopted school (Govt. Upper Primary School Bohipora) participated in the Yoga inaugural session. Speakers underscored the benefits of Yoga in unison of body and mind.
